for First Time Applicants

The Woman's Club of Jacksonville is privileged to offer scholarships to deserving students attending institutions for the purpose of extending knowledge, pursing career choices or acquiring skills needed for chosen professions. Scholarships can be awarded for any year the student is considered an undergraduate. No scholarships are awarded for post graduate students.

Scholarship amounts will be determined by The Woman's Club of Jacksonville.

Eligibility:

- Graduating High School Senior woman
- Woman who has completed her GED program
- Woman attending an accredited college, university or professional technical school

Required Documentation:

- Completed application form
- GPA of "B" or higher
- Essay of no more than <u>500</u> words including
 - \circ reasons for requesting scholarship
 - o applicant qualifications, aspirations, future educational plans
 - personal and professional goals
 - $_{\odot}\;$ other information the applicant would like the committee to know
- Transcript from current school (Original transcript not required, copies are acceptable)
- Community Service documentation with verification (can include hours outside school list)
- A recent picture of the applicant (with indication of permission to use image in publications)

The application and supporting documentation are due Sunday, April 6, 2025

Awards information:

The scholarship check will be made payable to the school and the recipient jointly and presented to the recipient at our club meeting on May 29, 2025. It will be the recipient's responsibility to endorse the check and then give the check to the school the recipient is or will be attending. Checks must be deposited by the school the recipient is attending and is not available for deposit by the recipient.

By accepting the scholarship, the recipient agrees to update The Woman's Club of Jacksonville if there is a change of plans for school attending or if the student withdraws from school.

Jerry Ferguson Memorial Scholarship

The Jerry Ferguson Memorial Scholarship is a onetime award to a graduating High School Senior Woman, resident of Florida. All graduating high school senior applications received for the Annual Scholarship are automatically eligible. Recipients of this award will be eligible for other scholarships as a returning applicant.

Additional information

Receipt of packet submitted will be acknowledged by email as will all notifications and selection of the recipient(s).

Recipients awarded the scholarships by the selection committee will be chosen without regard to race, ethnicity or religion.

NOTE: Applicants are ineligible if there has been or anticipates the acceptance of a four-year full tuition scholarship.
